# Who can participate?

**Voting members at each precinct caucus shall be:**

1. A registered Republican voter of the precinct for 22 days;
2. Registered to vote no later than 22 days (February 13, 2026) before the precinct caucus and affiliated with the Republican party for at least 22 days as shown on the registration books of the Fremont County Clerk and Recorder or on the records of the Colorado Secretary of State;
3. A registered Republican elector who has attained the age of 18 years within 22 days preceding such precinct caucus or who has become a naturalized citizen within 22 days immediately preceding the precinct caucus; and
4. A pre-Registrant who is 17 years of age on the date of the caucus and who will be 18 years of age on or before the date of the next general election.



At the Precinct Caucus, three sets of representatives are elected;

- The first set will consist of the Chairman and Secretary who will run the caucus meeting. Their position will end once the meeting concludes.
- The second set of representatives consists of two(2) Precinct Committee People (PCP) who will serve for two years. They will serve as the “eyes and ears” for the people in their precinct. They will communicate with the Fremont County Republican Party, Candidates and Elected Officials. Then pass that on to people in their precinct. They will represent the precinct at monthly meetings and events. As a voting member of the Fremont County Republican Central Committee, They will direct the activities of the Fremont County Republican Party.
- The third set of representatives consists of the **DELEGATES and ALTERNATES who will participate in the Fremont County Republican Assembly on March 21,2026 at Pathfinder Park.** These delegates will vote on behalf of their precinct constituency to determine which candidates will appear on the Republican Primary ballots for County positions. They will also elect the delegates and alternates to represent Fremont County at the Colorado State Republican Convention and Higher Districts. (SD4, HD60 and CD7). These will be held on April 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> at CSU Pueblo. More information to follow.
